his challenging situation in the other side also opens some opportunities for us to learn from everywhere, wider the learning exchange across countries. In 2020, our CEO and founder – Takeshi Takama taught sustainability for students of Clark High School in Japan.

The students were not only learning and listening to presentation but were active to practice and explore their creativity to create a solution. One of the interesting topics was the sustainable mask. Some of the ideas were very unique.

A student came out with the idea of edible mask, nap mask, mask with microphone, jelly mask, beak mask, water-soluble paper mask, even a mask that was inspired by culture. They all made the masks based on their experiences. By asking "why"

are they making those masks will help them to find vision.

In last year, we have also conducted 3 online ACT training in collaboration with Tigermov. Before pandemic, the students can get hands-on experiences by exploring Bali and meet with some local NGOs and local communities. However, in this online ACT we work more on social media campaign and creating videos on a particular theme. One of the most important issues talked in this program is waste management.
